Executive Committee Elections Autumn 2009

Pursuant to By-Laws, Article IX, Section 2, ExComm terms are three years. The first elections were autumn 2006. We will begin to proceed this summer according to By-Laws, Article X, Section 3, Paragraph 1 (BL X-3-1), by the Executive appointing a Nominating Committee. The following paragraph BL X-3-2 provides for an Election Committee to manage the elections. Board Members are appointed to these committees as volunteers.

Server Updates

Internet services to the Association were expanded Autumn 2008 to include email. This required a restructuring of the computer systems to distribute the computing load on multiple machines. The local network was divided into 2 networks to manage the expanded number of servers and work stations. Also, the internet connection was upgraded from residential to business class.

Cost for the update was distributed among participating entities proportional to their usage. The Association has paid approximately \$200+ for processor, system and flash memory. System redundancy was eliminated as the machines were rebuilt to specialize in assigned functions, thereby reducing reliability. An uninterruptible power supply (UPS) was purchased to compensate for the loss of reliability. The Association is being asked to pickup the cost of the \$75 UPS and dual backup batteries \$50.

Board members are now offered the opportunity to signup for an email address using @clancrawford.org server. Contact kevan@clancrawford.org to obtain an address and instructions.

Domain clancrawford.org registration expires in December 2009. Cost alternatives are being examined. Cost is expected to be US\$50 or less for 5 years.

Current membership is 208. Approximately 70 members are in the Family category.

Unfortunately, as noted in the Treasurer's report, we are encountering a problem with revenue from the membership. Approximately 6 people (2.9%) have not renewed in 2007 or have never paid for their membership. Another 57 people (27%) have not renewed in 2008. There are also 22 people who have not renewed in 2009 so far. To be fair, reminders have not been sent out for the 2009 renewals. This will be done in the next week or so along with the upcoming renewals for March 2009.

This lack of renewals is a critical issue for the organization. People have joined and enjoy the benefits of membership but are not supporting the organization. This is unfair to the people who are actively participating in the association.

Immediately, I propose suspending the membership rights of all those people who have neglected to renew up to the end of 2008. After a suitable time, we would suspend the rights of those who have not renewed in January and February of 2009 and continue this practice on a monthly basis. Privileges will be restored if people renew at a later date.

The Directors should be actively encouraging the members in their regions to renew their membership as it comes due so that we have the funds to support the required activities of the association.

Gathering & Tour Update

Simon's report will cover the state of preparations and reservations for the Homecoming Tour that Craufurdland is managing.

We will also go over preparations for The Gathering. We are registered for a Crawford tent. All paperwork has been submitted including data on who will assume responsibilities for various times.

We will need approval of the BOD for the tent fee which has not been required to be sent yet. There may be some adjustment but the price cited by the Gathering Committee is £235 for a Standard size tent (3 X 3 meters) which is the size we have ordered. The fee is currently equal to US \$338 which is a big savings from the almost \$500 that would have been the exchange amount in dollars just six months ago. Included in the rental are one table, 4 chairs, a flag pole, a printed clan name, and two staff passes per day. Wi-Fi will be available on site. Thus we hope we can have access to our website and maybe a power point display -- if someone gets creative between now and then.

With a more favorable exchange rate, we may find a few others becoming interested in going in spite of the terrible shape of the economy so we will be including a note in the next newsletter regarding. Simon said they had made a few tentative additional reservations and bought a few extra passports – about four.

DNA Project Update

We currently have 110 participants in the Crawford Y-DNA surname project. There are two additional individuals who have submitted their results from Ancestry, for a total of 112. There are a few others who are registered with Y-Search who have not joined our project. The main reason is that they did their analysis with a lab other than FTDNA who sponsors our project. There are increasing opportunities to transfer data from one lab to another, so we hope some of these individuals will be able to transfer to our project in the near future. The Y-DNA project is growing, with several new individuals joining the project every month.

Our project is still relatively small, but we now have identified several distinctive lines. There are 15 lineages with at least two individuals pertaining to each lineage. This has permitted us to reduce significantly the number of unclassified individuals (26 persons). The two largest lineages are Lineage 1 and Ardmillan. Lineage 1 has 32 members and is the primary Crawford lineage, probably descended from the Crawfordjohn Branch. Ardmillan has 11 members and is currently the second largest lineage. The identification of the origins of the other Crawford lineages is still uncertain. We do not currently have enough representatives, nor do we have clear documentation to tie them to definite origins -- and much less to each other. We suspect, however, that some of the R1b lineages may have common ancestry since or near to the time of the advent of surnames.

Kevan will describe changes in the web posting of the Y-DNA results.

The intro page includes only the lineage modal comparisons grouped by haplogroup. Lineages link to haplogroup pages where the raw data for each participant is found. Participants under "No assigned lineage" will be divided up in the future among the haplogroups into which they belong for direct comparison. Also, when the number of participants in a lineage reaches a critical number then the lineage will be separated from the haplogroup with its own page.

Regional Organization Issues

Contact with Membership and other interested Crawford:

I have an updated list for each Region that I can send you, and will do so after the Board meeting. In any case, we will have updated lists on the e-mail page open to those who are officers in the Association, including Board members.

To keep these lists up to date, I do need each of you to send me any contacts you are making in your Regions so that I can update our lists, or have them sign the visitor's log on the website. I send each new contact an e-mail inviting them to join the Association and a copy of the latest newsletter. I also describe the Y-DNA project and the Archive.

We suggest that you be in contact with them to encourage them to join the Association. Invite members and interested Crawford in your region to join you at the Games. I send out a notice to those in the local area to remind them of the games in their area and invite them to join us, including help with the tent if they are so inclined.

Regional Web Pages:

We have several Regional web pages already set up (England, Canada West, Pacific Coast, Arizona, New Mexico, Mid-west, Minnesota, South Carolina, New York). It would be great to add pages for the rest of the regions. These provide a point of contact for people from your area to contact someone in that region. Ralf Smart has been very helpful in getting some of these web sites set up. Contact him for assistance at general_ly@hotmail.com.

Tent Stipends:

About a year-and-a-half ago the Board approved three \$200 stipends for those setting up tents for the first time, to be granted upon request and review by a committee established for that purpose. One grant was given to Mary R. Crawford (Midwest Region). Another went to Terry and Scott to defer some of the Grandfather Mountain expenses. Terry Pea has also requested a grant that is pending.

We need to consider whether we would like to continue to make these grants available to those setting up for the first time. The Board would need to approve that. I suggest it would be a good idea to have available the possibility of granting one or two a year as needed. It does help defray initial costs that can easily be three to four hundred US dollars.

The tent grant committee as set up has not worked, thus I would suggest that it be composed of three members of the Board.

Comments by Terry Crawford:

The grants for setting up for the first time are helpful for smaller games where you provide your own tent, table, etc. Larger games, like GMHG, you pay for the rental of

pre-assigned tents, (much like The Gathering) with table and chairs. The cost is not a one-time set-up fee, but recurring yearly. Scott and I paid a couple hundred dollars out of pocket in addition to the stipend from the Association. We gathered over 30 names of interested folks. It is a four day event and takes considerable work to set-up and breakdown. I am willing to do it again, but feel there needs to be a permanent allocated stipend for games such as this. If I decide to attend smaller games I wouldn't expect assistance.

Suggestion: We may need to define which games we deem most strategic to our mission and that could return the biggest bang for the buck and supplement them with an annual stipend.

Was it included in the 2008 Budget? Is this a discretionary expenditure by the officers and do we have a set not-to-exceed limit without Board approval on such expenditures?
